#### 1. ELIGIBILITY and RULES of ORIGIN

Participation is open to all legal persons (participating either individually or in a grouping – consortium – of candidates/tenderers) which are effectively established in a Member State of the European Union or in a eligible country or territory as defined under the Regulation (EU) No 236/2014 establishing common rules and procedures for the implementation of the Union's instruments for external action (CIR) for the applicable instrument under which the contract is financed.

#### 2. ADMISSIBILITY CRITERIA

Only applications fulfilling the following criteria of admissibility will be evaluated:

- the deadline for the submission of applications has been respected;
- the application is complete;
- the candidate has signed the declaration on honor on exclusion criteria;
- the maximum budget is not exceeded.

#### 3. SELECTION CRITERIA

The following selection criteria will be applied to candidates. In the case of applications submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole unless specified otherwise. The selection criteria will not be applied to natural persons and single-member companies when they are sub-contractors.

#### - Legal status of candidate:

The candidate has a legal status and is not presenting the application as a natural person (Application form table 1)

### - Professional and technical capacity of candidate:

 The candidate has at least 1 person inside their staff specialized on project/program/policy evaluation (Application form table 2)















- The candidate has at least 3 years working on baseline development, logical framework and impact monitoring systems (Application form table 3)
- The candidate has at least 3 previous demonstrated project evaluation experiences (Application form table 3)

#### 4. AWARD CRITERIA

The applications will be evaluated in two separated phases:

- 1. In the first phase the evaluation committee will evaluate the technical offer using the following quality criteria:
  - Quality of the proposed methodology and evaluation tools (30 pts)
  - Assigned staff with academic certification and/or professional experiences in project evaluation and in the evaluation of EU funded projects (15 pts)
  - Assigned staff with knowledge of the Palestinian context and experience with conducting evaluations in Middle East (10pts)
  - Assigned staff with knowledge on policy and legal frameworks about the civil society and local authorities (5 pts)
  - Assigned staff with demonstrated reporting skills (10 pts)
  - Assigned staff with certificated/demonstrated skills in spoken and written English (15 pts)
  - Assigned staff with certificated/demonstrated skills in spoken and written Arabic (15 pts)

Any application falling short of the technical threshold of 75 out of 100 points, is automatically rejected.

2. In the second phase, the financial proposal will be evaluated. The financial offer will be noted on 20 scores. The application with the lowest total price receives 20 financial score.

For the final score of the offer, the best price-quality ratio is established by weighing technical quality against price using the following ponderation:

Technical quality: 80%

Price: 20%
